Ages Four to Six Years Old

9:15-9:20: Getting to Know You: “My Name is _____ and This is How I Dance”

9:20-9:25: Play warm-up game “All Hands on Deck”

9:25-9:35: Read Lilly’s Purple Plastic Purse as a circle group

9:35-9:40 Do an emotion circle with the feelings that Lilly goes through in the book. For each emotion, go around the circle and have children say one sentence that describes how they feel to accompany the physical pose:

- Love
- Sad
- Excited
- Angry
- Guilty
- Scared
- Happy

9:40-9:50 Walk around the room like different people we want to be when we grow up-take suggestions from everyone!

9:50-10:10 Make Purple Plastic Purses (or bags!) Kids can decorate the paper first, and it will be fitted inside the bags and secured with straps.

10:10-10:45 Group Storytelling: Three Little Pigs and Goldilocks and the Three Bears

10:45-11:05: SNACK

11:05-11:15: Group Storytelling: The Three Billy Goats Gruff

11:15- 11:30: Introduction to Drama Games- Museum

11:30-11:45: Magic Door Game: Children enter and move throughout the space as if they are inside the following environments:

- A jungle, On the moon, In an airport, At the beach, On a construction site, Under the sea, At the grocery store, At a rock concert, At Disney World

12:15-12:30: Talk about what makes a good story: a beginning, a middle, and an end, and a problem that needs to be solved. Do a one sentence story circle with puppets, make sure everyone has a chance to contribute one sentence to the story.
